Close to 3,000 elementary students expected to participate in inter-board track and field competition

Dorval QC., May 31, 2010 –A total of 2,700 students from over 30 different elementary schools will be participating in the activities ranging from long jumping and hurdles to relay races. “This is a great opportunity for our students to participate in a fun event that promotes physical fitness and allows them to showcase their skills,” said Peter Gilson, a Physical Education and Health Consultant at the LBPSB.

The track and field competition will take place over two days on June 1st and June 2nd with events scheduled to begin at 10am and ending at noon on both days. Rain dates have been scheduled for June 3rd and/or June 4th. The competition will be held at Riverdale High School located at 5060 Sources Boulevard in Pierrefonds.
