Mandate

1. To review LBPSB's Intercultural Policy and make recommendations to the Council of Commissioners regarding proposed changes;
2. To advise LBPSB on Intercultural concerns facing its community;
3. To recommend ways of integrating intercultural and global education into school curricula and into the school life of LBPSB schools;
4. To review local intercultural projects and to recommend the distribution of resources provided by the School Tax Management Committee of the Island of Montréal;
5. To encourage schools and centres to develop local intercultural projects.
