Committee Mandate and Composition

Per Resolution 2019-03-#05

Mandate

1. To study and oversee the development of policies, procedures, programs, and facilities (in cooperation with other standing and advisory committees of the School Board) related to educational and complementary educational services in the day care, kindergarten (4 & 5), youth, and continuing education sectors of the LBPSB;
2. To evaluate the implementation of policies, procedures, programs, and facilities (in cooperation with other standing and advisory committees of the School Board) related to educational and complementary educational services in the day care, kindergarten (4 & 5), youth and continuing education sectors of the LBPSB, and make appropriate recommendations to Council;
3. To undertake any other tasks as assigned to it by Council;
4. To report to Council on a monthly basis during the school year.

Composition

The Programs and Services Committee is constituted of the number of Commissioners determined by Council, by the number of administrators determined by the Director General, and by representatives of the Parents Committee and the Special Needs Advisory Committee.

Source (Education Act)

193.1. The council of commissioners must establish the following committees:

- (1) a governance and ethics committee;
- (2) an audit committee; and
- (3) a human resources committee.

(...)

The council of commissioners may establish other committees to assist it in the exercise of its functions or the examination of specific matters.
