

Transportation Advisory Committee

Committee Mandate and Composition

Per Resolution 2019-03-#05

Mandate

1. To fulfill the statutory requirements of the Council of Commissioners with respect to the Transportation Advisory Committee as defined in the Regulation respecting Student Transportation, more specifically to give its opinion on:
 - The planning, coordinating, financing and administration of student transportation;
 - The student transportation organization plan;
 - The granting of contracts for the transportation of students,
 - The criteria and terms and conditions to allow other persons to use the transportation services;
 - The use of all or part of the amount of a transportation subsidy for other purposes (as permitted);
2. To review Board policies and procedures relative to transportation matters and to make recommendations to the Council of Commissioners;
3. To carry out any other task assigned to it by the Council.

Composition

As per the Regulation Respecting Student Transportation, the advisory committee on student transportation of a board shall consist of the following members (LBPSB):

- The director general or the assistant director general of the board;
- The person responsible for the student transportation services of the board;
- The principal of a school of the board;
- A representative of the parents' committee of the board;
- 2 school commissioners of the board;
- A representative of each public transit authority whose territory intersects with that of the board (STM and EXO).

Legal basis (Education Act)

188. Every school board which provides student transportation shall establish an advisory committee on transportation the composition, operation and functions of which shall meet the norms established by government regulation.
