



Electoral Division Boundaries

Lester B. Pearson School Board Proposal

In accordance with sections 6-10 of the Act Respecting School Elections, the Council of Commissioners of the Lester B. Pearson School Board on August 28, 2006 unanimously adopted a proposal for the division of its territory into 21 electoral divisions, setting the boundaries of each of these divisions and establishing the number of electors therein, for the purposes of the general election of school commissioners to be held across Québec on Sunday, November 4, 2007.

The proposal may be examined at 1925 Brookdale Avenue, Dorval during normal business hours, Monday – Friday (area maps are appended and specific division-by-division maps are available upon request). The proposal can also be accessed through the Board website at (www.lbpsb.qc.ca). Any elector may inform the Director General in writing, addressed to 1925 Brookdale Avenue, Dorval, Québec H9P 2Y7, of any objection to this division proposal within 15 days of publication of this notice. Should 351 or more electors register in writing their objection to the proposal, the Council of Commissioners will hold a public meeting to hear the persons present in respect of the division proposal.

- *The words highway, avenue, boulevard, road, street, railroad, canal, lake and river indicate a line drawn behind the properties facing on them, unless otherwise described;*
- *The names and boundaries of the municipalities shown are those in effect as of January 1, 2006;*
- *The description of the boundaries of the proposed electoral divisions (number of electors bracketed at end) is:-*

1 - The division comprises the borough of Verdun, City of Montreal. (3359)

2 - The division comprises a part of the borough of LaSalle, City of Montreal, bounded as follows: beginning from a point situated at the intersection of the Saint-Lawrence River and the canal of the Aqueduct, the median of this canal, Shevchenko Boulevard (northeast side), Jean-Chevalier street (northwest side), the northeast and southeast municipal limits back to the starting point. 3 - The division comprises a part of the borough of LaSalle, City of Montreal, bounded as follows: beginning from a point situated at the intersection of the northwestern limit of the borough of LaSalle and Dollard Avenue (southwest side), the northwest and northeast municipal limits, Jean-Chevalier Street (northwest side), Shevchenko Boulevard (northeast side), the median of the canal of the Aqueduct, Dollard Avenue (northeast side), the median of Newman Boulevard, the extension of Preville Street, Preville Street (northeast side), the extension of Preville Street, Hardy Street (southeast and northeast sides), Corder Street (northwest side) and Dollard Avenue (northeast side) back to the starting point. (3273)

4 - The division comprises a part of the borough of Lachine, City of Montreal, situated north of the median of Highway 20 and east of the median of Chomedey Highway (13).

Comprises also a part of the borough of LaSalle, City of Montreal, bounded as follows: beginning from a point situated at the intersection of the northwestern limit of the borough of LaSalle

and Dollard Avenue, Dollard Avenue (northeast side), Corder Street (northwest side), Hardy Street (northeast and southeast sides), the extension of Preville Street, Preville Street (northeast side), the extension of the median of Preville Street, the median of Newman boulevard, Dollard Avenue (northeast side), the median of the canal of the Aqueduct and the southeastern, southwestern and northwestern limits of the borough of LaSalle, to the intersection of the Lachine Canal with Route 138, the median of Route 138 back to the starting point. (3111)

5 - The division comprises a part of the borough of Lachine, City of Montreal, situated west of the median of Chomedey Highway (13) and south of the median of Highway 20. (3221)

6 - The division comprises the Municipality of Dorval Island.

Comprises also a part of the City of Dorval situated southeast of the median of Reverchon Avenue and its northeast extension. (3642)

7 - The division comprises a part of the City of Pointe-Claire bounded as follows: beginning from a point situated at the intersection of the medians of Montée Saint-Rémi and Reverchon Avenue, Reverchon Avenue up to Newman Crescent, Reverchon Avenue (northwest side), Saint-Louis Avenue (northwest side), Delmar Avenue (northeast side) to Tecumseh Avenue (northeast side), the northwestern and northeastern municipal limits and the median of Montée Saint-Rémi back to the starting point.

Comprises also that part of the City of Dorval situated northwest of the median of Reverchon Avenue and its northeast extension.

Comprises also that part of the City of Dollard-des-Ormeaux situated northeast of the median of Des Sources Boulevard.

Comprises also a part of the borough of Pierrefonds-Roxboro, City of Montreal, bounded as follows: beginning from a point situated at the intersection of the northeastern municipal limit with the City of Dollard-des-Ormeaux and the railroad, by a line drawn northeast to Gouin Boulevard West and Deslauriers Street, Deslauriers Street (southwest side) and its extension, the borough northern, eastern and southeastern municipal limits back to the starting point. (3282)

8 - The division comprises a part of the borough of Pierrefonds-Roxboro, City of Montreal, bounded as follows: beginning from a point situated at the intersection of Richmond Street and de Pierrefonds Boulevard, de Pierrefonds Boulevard (northwest side), Perron Street (west side) and its extension north, the northern municipal limit of the borough, the extension of the median of Deslauriers Street, this street (west side) up to Gouin Boulevard West, a line drawn southwest to the municipal limit of the borough of Pierrefonds-Roxboro, this limit, the eastern extension of the median of Shelborne, this street (excluding only Beechwood School at 13155 Shelborne), the municipal limit of the borough and Richmond Street (northeast side) back to the starting point. (3043)

9 - The division comprises a part of the City of Pointe-Claire bounded as follows: beginning from a point situated at the intersection of the median of Saint-Jean Boulevard and the northern limit of this City, the northwestern and northeastern municipal limits, Tecumseh Street (northeast side) and its extension south, Delmar Avenue (northeast side), Saint-Louis Avenue (northwest side), the eastern limit of the City, the median of Highway 20, Saint-Jean Boulevard (northeast side) back to the starting point. (3668)

10 - The division comprises a part of the City of Pointe-Claire bounded as follows: beginning from a point situated at the intersection of the median of Highway Felix-Leclerc (40) and Saint-Jean Boulevard (east side), this boulevard (east side), the median of Highway 20, the east, south and west municipal limits, the median of Highway Felix-Leclerc (40) back to the starting point. (3636)

11 - The division comprises a part of the City of Dollard-des-Ormeaux bounded as follows: beginning from a point situated at the intersection of the medians of Baffin Street and Anselme-Lavigne (municipal boundary), the northwest and northeast municipal limits, the median of des Sources Boulevard, the southern limit of this City, Tecumseh Street (southwest side), Lake Road (northwest side), Martinique Street (southwest side), Myconos Street (southeast and southwest sides), Baffin Street (southwest side), Florence Street (southeast, southwest and northwest sides), Baffin Street (southwest side) back to the starting point.

Comprises also a part of the borough of Pierrefonds-Roxboro, City of Montreal, bounded as follows: beginning from a point situated at the intersection of the medians of Anselme-Lavigne Avenue and Shelborne Street, Shelborne Street (including only Beechwood School at 13155 Shelborne), the extension east of Shelborne to the municipal boundary of the City of Dollard-des-Ormeaux, this limit back to the starting point. (3760)

12 - The division comprises the borough of L'Île-Bizard-Sainte-Geneviève, City of Montreal.

Comprises also a part of the borough of Pierrefonds-Roxboro, City of Montreal, bounded as follows: beginning from a point situated at the intersection the northern limit of the borough (between Saint-Paul and Jérémie Streets) and the rivière des Prairies, this river, the extension of the median of Perron street, this street (west side), de Pierrefonds Boulevard (northwest side), Richmond Street (northeast side), the southern limit of the borough, the median of Saint-Jean Boulevard, Harry-Worth Street (southeast and southwest sides), de Pierrefonds Boulevard (southeast side), Jacques-Bizard Boulevard (northeast side), Oakwood Street (northwest side), Acres Road (southwest side), Dupuis Street (west side), Sainte-Croix Street (southeast side), Sainte-Anne Street (northeast side), de Pierrefonds Boulevard (northwest side), the municipal limit of this borough back to the starting point. (3532)

13 - The division comprises part of the borough of Pierrefonds-Roxboro, City of Montreal, bounded as follows: beginning from a point situated at the intersection of Jacques-Bizard Boulevard (southwest side) and de Pierrefonds Boulevard (southeast side), this boulevard (southeast side), Harry-Worth Street (southeast and southwest sides), the median of Saint-Jean Boulevard, the west and north borough limit with the City of Dollard-des-Ormeaux, Sommerset Street (northeast side), Jacques-Bizard Boulevard (northeast side) back to the starting point.

Comprises also a part of the City of Dollard-des-Ormeaux bounded as follows: beginning from a point situated at the intersection of the median of Saint-Jean Boulevard and the northern municipal limit of the City, this limit, Baffin Street (southwest side), Florence Street (northwest, southwest and southeast sides), Baffin Street (southwest side), Martinique Street (southwest side), Myconos Street (northwest, southwest and southeast sides), Martinique Street (southwest side), Lake Road (northwest side), Tecumseh Street (southwest side), the southeastern municipal limit, Saint-Jean Boulevard (southwest side), Shakespeare Street (southeast side), Sommerset Street (northeast side) and the north and west municipal limits back to the starting point. (3082)

14 - The division comprises a part of the City of Dollard-des-Ormeaux bounded as follows: beginning from a starting point at the intersection of the northwest limit of the City of Kirkland with the southwest limit of the City of Dollard-des-Ormeaux, this limit, Sommerset Street (northeast side), Shakespeare Street (southeast side), Saint-Jean Boulevard (southwest side), the southeast and southwest municipal limits of this City back to the starting point.

Comprises also the part of the City of Pointe-Claire situated northwest of the median of Highway Felix-Leclerc (40) and east of Saint-Jean Boulevard (northeast side).

Comprises also a part of the City of Kirkland bounded as follows: beginning from a point at the intersection of northeast municipal limit of this City with Highway Felix-Leclerc (40), the northeast and south municipal limits, the median of Saint-Charles Boulevard, the northwest and northeast municipal limits of the City of Kirkland back to the starting point. (3679)

15 - The division comprises a part of the City of Beaconsfield bounded as follows: beginning from a point at the intersection of the northwest limit of this City with the City of Kirkland, the northwest, east and south municipal limits of the City of Beaconsfield, the extension of the median of Saint-Charles

Boulevard, this boulevard (west side), the median of Highway 20, the eastern limit of this City back to the starting point. (3295)

16 - The division comprises a part of the City of Kirkland situated southwest of the median of Saint-Charles Boulevard.

Comprises also a part of the City of Sainte-Anne-de-Bellevue bounded as follows: beginning from a point situated at the intersection of this City's eastern municipal limit with the median of Highway Felix-Leclerc (40), this highway, the extension of the median of Meloche Street, this street (southwest side), Tremblay Street (southwest side) and its extension north, the northwest and east municipal limits of this City back to the starting point. (3238)

17 - The division comprises a part of the borough of Pierrefonds-Roxboro, City of Montreal, bounded as follows: beginning from a point at the intersection of the western limit of this borough with the Village of Senneville and the City of Sainte-Anne-de-Bellevue, the western and northern limits of this borough, the southeast limit of the borough of L'Île-Bizard-Sainte-Geneviève, de Pierrefonds Boulevard (northwest side) to the east of des Jacinthes Street, Sainte-Anne Street (northeast side), Sainte-Croix Street (southeast side), Dupuis Street (west side), Acres Street (southwest side), Oakwood Street (northwest side), Sommerset Street (northeast side), the southern and western limits of this borough back to the starting point. (3544)

18 - The division comprises the Town of Baie-d'Urfé and the Village of Senneville.

Comprises also a part of the City of Sainte-Anne-de-Bellevue bounded as follows: beginning from a point situated at the intersection of the southern limit of this City with the western limit of the Town of Baie-d'Urfé, the southern, western and northern municipal limits of the City of Sainte-Anne-de-Bellevue, the north extension of Tremblay Street (southwest side), this street (southwest side), Meloche Street (southwest side) and its extension

south, the boundary between the municipalities of the City of Sainte-Anne-de-Bellevue and the Town of Baie-d'Urfé back to the starting point.

Comprises also a part of the City of Beaconsfield bounded as follows: beginning from a point situated at the intersection of the western limit the City of Beaconsfield and the median of Highway 20, this highway, Saint Charles Boulevard (west side) and its extension, the south and west limits of this City back to the starting point. (3388)

19 - The division comprises the following municipalities: L'Île-Perrot(V), Terrasse-Vaudreuil(M), Pincourt(V) and Notre-Dame-de-l'Île-Perrot(V). (3271)

20 - The division comprises the following municipalities: Très-Saint-Rédempteur(P), Sainte-Marthe(M), Sainte-Justine-de-Newton(P), Saint-Clet(M), Coteau-du-Lac(M), Les Coteaux(M), Saint-Polycarpe(M), Saint-Zotique(VL), Rivière-Beaudette(M), Saint-Télesphore(P), Les Cèdres(M), Pointe-des-Cascades(VL), L'Île-Cadieux(V) and Vaudreuil-sur-le-Lac(VL).

Comprises also the parts of Vaudreuil-Dorion and Hudson situated southeast of Côte Saint-Charles (southeast side) and its northern extension. (3251)

21 - The division comprises the following municipalities: Saint-Lazare(V), Rigaud(M) et Pointe-Fortune(VL).

Comprises also parts of the municipalities of Vaudreuil-Dorion and Hudson situated northwest of Côte Saint-Charles (southeast side) and its northern extension. (3311)
