What is SNAC?

SNAC refers to the Special Needs Advisory Committee. SNAC is a committee that advises the school board on policies that apply to students with special needs and on the allocation of financial resources to the services intended for these students.

The committee is mandated by the Education Act which states that “every school board shall establish an advisory committee on services for handicapped students and students with social maladjustments or learning disabilities”.

Who are its members?

The committee is made up of parents of students on an I.E.P. , teachers, school administrators, professionals, commissioners, support staff and representatives from community agencies.

How do I get involved?

On Sept 29th 2021, parents of students with special needs, who are interested, will be selected to hold positions on the committee. We encourage all parents of students on an I.E.P. to attend, cast your vote for the selection of members and get involved!

When are SNAC meetings?

Special Needs Advisory Committee meetings are held monthly throughout the school year. All parents of students on an I.E.P. are welcome to attend and observe the monthly meetings. We have two public question periods each meeting.
