Requirements and considerations

Students enrolled in the LBPSB Summer Enrichment Program 2021 must:

- Attend all classes.
- Have access to their lbpearson.ca Google account.
- Have a functional headset (preferably USB) with microphone. The combination of earphones and an integrated mic will also suffice.
- Be comfortable using an online platform to communicate with a teacher, send and receive assignments.
- Have access to an up-to-date personal computer with broadband connection capable of running the latest version of Chrome Web Browser.
- Have access to a personal device (such as a smartphone, tablet, or webcam) that can take clear pictures and upload them online.

LBPSB Summer Program 2021

The Summer Program curriculum will be based on the essential components of courses offered during the regular school year. Students and parents should be aware that there is not sufficient time to cover all course content during the Summer Program session. Important topics will be reviewed and taught, but it will be the student's responsibility to make sure that they are properly prepared for the evaluations. It is important that students attend classes. Attendance is taken daily and phone calls are made home. Successful completion of any course does not guarantee placement for the subsequent school year. **This decision rests with the student's home school administration.**

Math Bridge Program

Options: Math Bridge CST to T&S OR Math Bridge CST to SN

Eligibility:

- Students must have successfully completed Sec. 4 Math CST during the school year.
- Must be a grade 10 student at LBPSB.
- Students must have approval from their school principal.

Program & Exam Schedule:

- The Math Bridge program will run for 3 weeks - from **July 5th through July 23rd, 2021.**
- Students in either course will write the Situational Problem (C1) and Reasoning (C2) exam in-class during the 3 week course of the summer program.

Cost:

3-week tutorial (\$210) + 2 exams (\$45+\$45) = **\$300.00**
