

## To the parents or guardians of children aged 5-11 who attend Lester B. Pearson School Board

Further to Health Canada's approval of the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine for children aged 5-11, the Ministère de la Santé et des Services sociaux is pleased to announce the rollout of the vaccination campaign for this age group.

You have two options for getting your child vaccinated:

1. **Make an appointment at a vaccination centre, by clicking the following link:**

Time slots have been reserved for children at all CISSS de la Montérégie-Ouest vaccination sites to ensure their experience is as smooth as possible. If your child is accompanied by someone other than a parent, they will need to show the consent form filled out and signed by you. Here is the link to the consent form:

2. **Have your child vaccinated at their school during vaccination day.**

You will be taken to the platform for your school service centre, where you will be asked to register the child at their school. Please note that the time is approximate, as school staff will coordinate appointments onsite. Since you will not be with your child at school when they are vaccinated, **you must answer all the administrative and medical questions in Clic Santé** and give your consent for your child to be vaccinated.

**IMPORTANT:** Only children who are registered in Clic Santé will be vaccinated by the mobile school team.

Note that the child must be **aged 5 to 11 years on the day of the vaccination**. If your child is 12 years old and still not vaccinated, we encourage you to book an appointment on the COVID-19 vaccination site, during a time slot reserved for people aged 12 and over: [Clic Santé](#).
