



School board election on November 3, 2024 - Revision of the list of electors

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given to the electors of the school board that:

1. Elections will be held in wards 2, 6 and 9. The residents of each ward in election will elect the commissioner representing their ward.
2. The list of electors of LBPSB is subject to revision and may be consulted at the office of the Returning Officer. To verify if you are registered, please consult: <https://www.lbpsb.qc.ca/council-of-commissioners/school-board-elections-consultations/>.
3. To be registered on the list of electors, any person must, on polling day (November 3, 2024):
 - **Be:** at least 18 years of age; Canadian citizen; domiciled in the territory of the school board and having been domiciled in Quebec for at least six (6) months;
Not: be under curatorship and not have been convicted within the last five years of an offence constituting a corrupt electoral or referendum practice; **and:**
 - Have a child admitted to the educational services of the LBPSB **or** have registered on the list of electors of LBPSB by completing the notice of choice or by appearing before the Revision Board **on/before October 15, 2024**.
