





Deadline to Contact me or complete the Exam Google Form if your child needs to be registered to write final MEQ or Board exams in June 2025.






Learning Project
















Graduation Requirements

The Quebec Secondary School Diploma is awarded when a student earns <u>54 credits</u> by passing courses in secondary 4 & 5.

Certain courses are compulsory. At least 20 credits must come from passing secondary 5 level courses.

Compulsory credits in secondary 4:

Math

Science

History

Arts education

Compulsory credits in secondary 5:

English

French

PE or Culture & Citizenship in Quebec


Additional credits earned from passing other secondary 4 and 5 level courses.

Many courses required for graduation involve a MEQ + Board component to the achieve the final mark and receive credits.


The DEM is not concerned with credits; only that uniform exams are written.

Students can achieve the required 54 credits to achieve a Quebec Secondary School Diploma through homeschooling; it simply requires a little extra planning!




