# Student Transportation Organizational Plan



# INTRODUCTION

Under the Education Act, Section 454 specifies that the *Regulation Respecting Student Transportation* will dictate how the Board will establish its Advisory Committee on Student Transportation.

Under the Regulation (Sections 7 to 11), the Advisory Committee is mandated to give its opinion to the Board on the Board's Student Transportation Organizational Plan.

The Plan is proposed each year, as early as possible before the end of June, by the Board's Administration to the Advisory Committee in order that it may give its opinion to Council as required by Regulation.

Once adopted by Council, the Plan becomes the Board's course of action in matters related to student transportation in full compliance with the Ministry of Education du Québec's "Règles budgétaires pour le transport scolaire".

**School hours** and **transportation zones** are thus set in this Plan to maximize available financial resources and to comply with the Board's Operating Budget approved by the Council.

## SCHOOL HOURS

School hours are determined by the Board yearly and confirmed by this Plan. Schools through their Governing Boards may propose school hours to Administration. School bus operations ultimately define when schools will start and finish in full respect of the established "Régime Pédagogique".

The **2025-2026 school hours**, as well as the proposed supervision times for the disembarkment and embarkment of students in school bus loading zones, are tabled with this document.

# TRANSPORTATION ZONES

The territory of the Lester B. Pearson School Board is divided into several small geographical catchment areas known as attendance zones. The boundaries of these zones are defined in this document as “**Summary of Attendance Zones**”.

The creation of transportation zones is guided by these school attendance zones and is in accordance with the LBPSB student transportation policy. Transportation zones indicate which students will receive school bus transportation and which families will receive financial compensation for student use of public transportation to and from school in lieu of school bussing.

Six types of transportation services and/or entitlements will be offered during the **2025-2026** school year:

- 1- Free school bus for kindergarten to grade 6 students
- 2- Free school bus for grades 7 and 8 only (“Green service”)
- 3- Free school bus for grades 7 to 11 (“Blue service”)
- 4- Free school bus for grades 11 (“Grey”)
- 5- Parent allocation (\$300 per school year, per child) for public transportation).
- 6- Transportation for a fee

## 2025-2026 USER FEES

### Empty Seat Program

The “Empty Seat” Program offers a variety of services permitted under section 298 of the Education Act. There are 3 types of scenarios that are possible:

- Empty seat – ‘courtesy’ service. The courtesy service is provided, if available, to students residing within the distances established under section 4.1 who would not normally be eligible for daily transportation (morning and afternoon).
- Empty seat – ‘accommodation’ service. The accommodation service is provided, if available to students residing outside the transportation zones as established by the board under the plan and who would not normally be eligible for daily transportation (morning and afternoon).
- Empty seat – ‘alternative address’ service. The alternative address service is provided, if available, to students requiring transportation to and from an address other than their residence.

For the purpose of rationalizing transportation services, some attendance zones have been divided along an east-west or north-south line. The following description explains how these divisions will be applied by the Transportation Services for the purpose of determining transportation entitlement for **2025-2026 school year**:

## **ZONE 1**

Divided by a line corresponding to the D.D.O./Pierrefonds boundary, all students within this zone and residing in Pierrefonds will be deemed to reside in the 1N zone and all those residing in D.D.O. will be assigned to zone 1S.

## **ZONE 3, 4, 7,10, 12, 14**

Divided by a line corresponding to the outer limits of the 2.4 km “walking” distance zones of either Pierrefonds C.H.S. or Sources Adult and Career Centre, all students residing within this combined 2.4 km “walking” distance zone will be deemed to reside in zones 3W, 4N, 7N, 10N, 12N, 14E and all those residing in the remaining portion of each of these attendance zones will be assigned respectively to zones 3E, 4S, 7S, 10S, 12S, 14W.

## **ZONE 9**

Divided by a line from Pierrefonds Blvd. and St-John Blvd. to the shores of Rivière-des-Prairies encompassing Ile Bizard back to Jacques Bizard Blvd., to Pierrefonds Blvd and St-John Blvd., all students residing within this zone will be deemed to reside in the 9A zone and all those remaining in zone 9 will be assigned to zone 9B.

## **ZONE 30**

All students residing on Ile-des-Soeurs will be deemed to reside in the 30E zone and all those residing on the Island of Montreal, in Verdun will be assigned to zone 30W.

## **ZONE 49**

Zone 49W and 49E are divided by a line corresponding to the outer limits of the 2.4 km “walking” distance zone of Macdonald H.S., all students residing within this 2.4 km “walking” distance zone will be deemed to reside in zone 49W and all those residing in the remaining portion will be assigned to zone 49E.

The **2025-2026 Transportation Zones** are annexed to this document detailing the corresponding transportation services and/or entitlements offered for each zone.
