- La Commission des Écoles Catholiques de Verdun
- The Lakeshore School Board
- The Protestant School Board of Greater Montreal

Today, the LBPSB is one of the largest English school boards in Québec and serves the English-eligible population on the western end of Montreal Island and off-island territory in the Monteregie-Ouest.

The school board plans to promote different events/activities during the year to mark its 25 years of excellence in education including social media campaigns, news articles and commemorative merchandise. There will also be a special 25th anniversary logo and website banner as well as anniversary themed events, including music concerts and talent shows.
