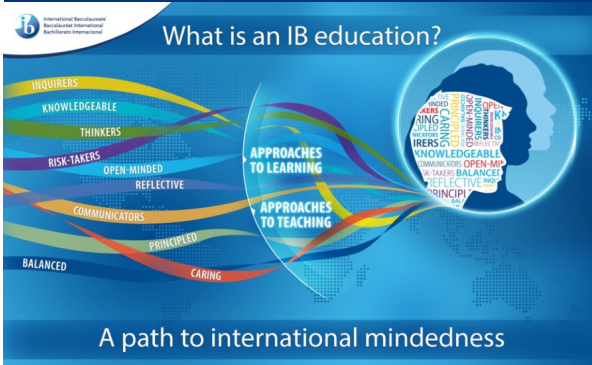




WHOLE SCHOOL INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE PROGRAMME

In 2009, Lakeside Academy became the first and only high school in the Lester B. Pearson School Board to offer the IB programme to all students.

An IB education focuses on the whole student, aiming to develop students into inquiring, knowledgeable and caring individuals. The Middle Years Programme (MYP) is designed to give students the tools and confidence they need to become lifelong learners by acquiring a number of skills that will serve them well in the future such as: developing good study habits, critical thinking and problem-solving skills and how to work independently in order to drive their own learning. By the time they graduate from Lakeside, students will be more culturally aware of themselves and of others. Upon graduation, students in the Enriched Program will receive an IB certificate from Cardiff and students in the regular stream will be awarded a Lakeside IB Certificate.

Sports
