- A full year devoted to school transition.
- A commitment to fostering a welcoming atmosphere that includes parents as partners in their child's education.
- An opportunity for a collaboration between K4 and K5 teachers, educators and other professionals to ensure a smooth entry into formal schooling.

Class behaviour expectations

*All students will be expected to put their best foot forward to create a classroom filled with respect, encouragement and kindness.

*K4 is about setting the foundation for these tiny and adorable humans to become kind, thoughtful, inquisitive and open-minded students.

*In class we will discuss and brainstorm together what a great class should look, feel and sound like. This will give the students active responsibility in knowing what is expected of them to keep a positive class environment.

*Daily routines are in place to give the students a sense of security and to know what is coming and what is expected from them. There is also a visual chart of the daily schedule.
