Zoned

- » K4 and K5 students receive busing
- » Consult school board transportation page to see if you quality

Out of Zone

- » Register at home school
- » Fill in transfer request
 - » Wait on word from school
- May be eligible for complimentary bussing at a cost (\$)

Pros

Early Immersion = Success

VS

St. Anthony Immersion Program

- » Kindergarten to Grade 2,85% of day in French
- » Grade 3 to grade 6, English and French split roughly 50/50
- » Immersion is most effective when introduced at an early age



Bilingual Program

» Kindergarten to grade 6 is split roughly 50/50



What is The Zone?



"What do I need?"



The Zone is a space set up to offer a variety of tools for students to use as they begin learning the important skill set of self-regulation. I use the Zones of Regulation Curriculum to help students identify how they are feeling and then guide them in

choosing what tool(s) might help them return to an emotional state best suited for learning. Some of

the possible tools that are available in the Zone are: coloring independently, pedaling a stationary bike, taking a few quiet minutes in the teepee, sitting on a bean bag chair with a quiet fidget, using one of the large yoga balls (older students) or the "peanut" (younger students mostly), beading, Kinetic sand, drawing at the "How do I feel?" table and talking about what's bothering them.





A student may be asked by their classroom teacher to take a break in the Zone or a student may ask independently. Breaks are highly structured and with the specific goal of helping the student refocus and return to class ready to learn. These structured breaks typically take 5 to 10 minutes and each student works independently while working to re-focus.

Daycare

General Information





- Over 65% of school population attend St. Anthony Daycare
- Government subsidized
 - Daycare fees dictated by the government
 - Invoiced monthly as per school calendar
 - No provincial tax receipt issued for daycare fees
- All daycare educators are government certified
- All staff CPR certified, yearly EpiPen training provided
- Attendance and eligibility
 - As per government regulations to be eligible students must be registered and attending a minimum of 3 days per week, 2 periods per day



Lunch and Daycare Programs Fees

Lunch Program Only	\$2.25 per day	 Non-daycare students who eat lunch at school supervision only
Daycare Program (3 days a week minimum)	\$8.55 per day	 Includes AM, Lunch, PM periods Min 3 days/week - min 2 periods per day Government Subsidized - Federal Tax receipt only
Daycare Program (2 days or less)	\$14.00 per day + \$2.25 lunch	No government subsidy
Daycare Ped. Day Cost	\$10.00	additional activity fee, variable



- Daycare Service available as per school calendar
- Ratio
 - Government ratio is 1 educator to 20 students (1:20)
 - St. Anthony reduces kindergarten ratio 1 educator to 12 students (1:12)
- Ped Day Activities
 - Ped Day field trips in French when possible.
 - Registration for individual Ped Day 2 3 weeks prior as per your needs
 - Lower ratios offered for kindergarten on field trips (1:7) as well as lower ratios for grade 1 - 6



Daycare

- Security for K4 and K5
 - Kindergarten students placed in age appropriate daycare groups during the 3 periods (morning, lunch, and afterschool periods),
 - Remain in their kindergarten classrooms ensuring consistency, familiarity and size appropriate washroom facilities
 - Separate fenced in school yard accessible from kindergarten classrooms
 - Hop Hop app used to facilitate pick up
 - Daycare staff will meet & greet parents walkie talkie used to communicate between staff
 - Open communication with parents



Daycare Planned Programming

- Planned programs
 - Phys. ed. program older students cross country ski, tennis, physical development skills practiced through games
 - Arts and crafts based on monthly themes
 - Technology robotics, coding
 - Cooking
 - Sewing
 - Homework supervision offered daily
 - Science
