### Eligibility

Secondary 4 students may register for a summer course as long as that course appears on their MEES Achievement Record and that their summary mark is below 59% (not passed). **Students who successfully passed the course can't register for summer school 2021.**

### LBPSB Summer Program 2021

The Summer Program curriculum will be based on the essential components of courses offered during the regular school year. Students and parents should be aware that there is not sufficient time to cover all course content during the Summer Program session. Important topics will be reviewed and taught, but it will be the student's responsibility to make sure that they are properly prepared for the evaluations. It is important that students attend all classes. Attendance is taken daily and phone calls are made home. Successful completion of any course does not guarantee placement for the subsequent school year. **This decision rests with the student's home school administration.**

### Courses

Students will be allowed to register for up to 2 courses, provided they appear on their MEES report card. Courses will only be offered where numbers warrant it. Class schedules are divided into two sections, **8:30-10:20** and **10:30-12:20**. Students must make themselves available to attend all classes.

### Course Fees

Course fees reflect program duration and number of exams. No refunds will be awarded after the 1st day of classes.

### Family Rate

The maximum charge to a single family for program/tutorial fees is \$500.00.
